The general area has lots of row crops which give great nutrition to the deer in the area. There are nice trails throughout the property for hiking, access for hunting and enjoying your property.

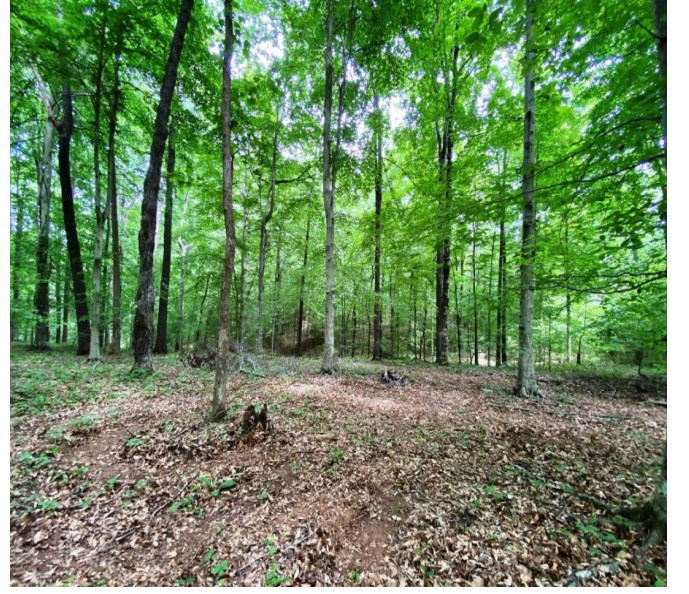
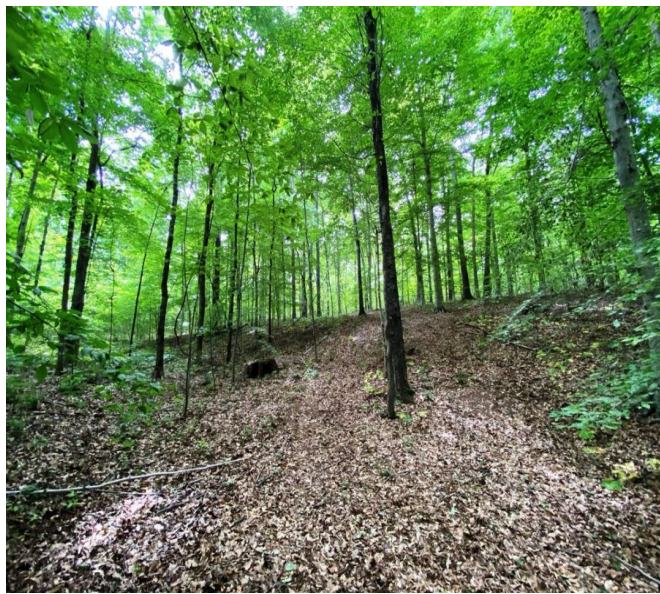
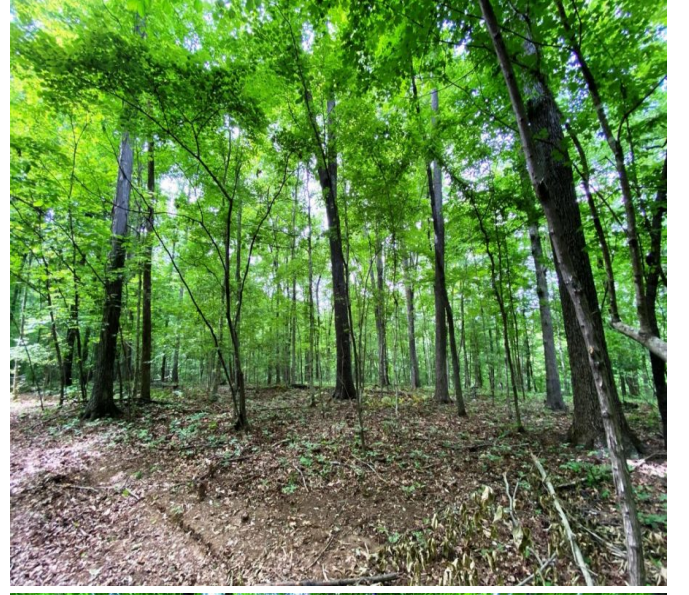
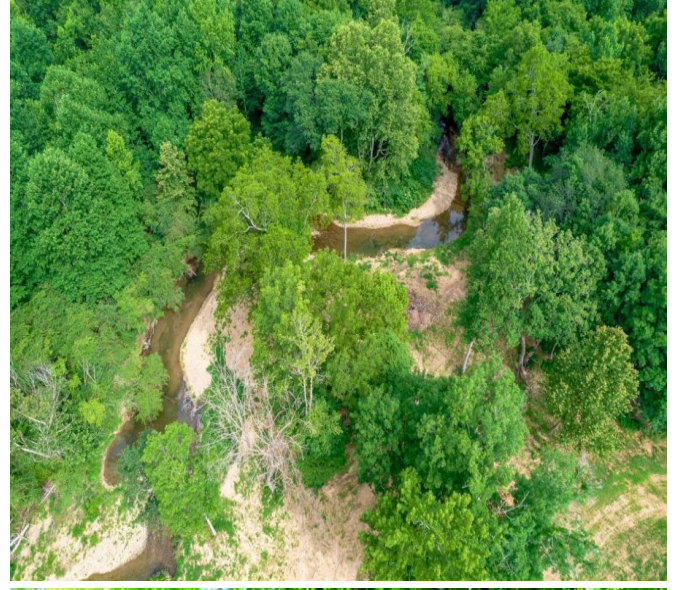
